I would like to start off by introducing myself. My name is Lekishia Mcknight, I am 36 years old and a single mother of one. I was raised in what I considered the roughest part of Orlando. I always held this desire to become a hairstylist. The desire was bottled up on the inside of me.I left it there for years ignoring my passion. See where I came from you didn't carry dreams you carried hope !!!!!. My hope was in making it to see my 18th birthday. My hope was in making it home from school everyday. My hope was that we had more than coffee to fill my stomach at night. My hope was that the lights and hot water wouldn't be turned off again that week. My hope was that bullets from a drive by shooting would miss our home. My hope was that my dad would be released from prison. My hope was that my mom would be delivered from her 35 year drug addiction. My hope was that my nieces and nephews would not become a product of their environment. My hope was in surviving as a little girl. I held no hope of being successful or having a career.

Once I grew up and discovered who I was, I began to revisit that passion I had burning on the inside. I remember how I would sit on my porch doing everyone's hair in the neighborhood. I fell in love with hair at the age of 8. When I did hair I felt free. I felt creative. I felt important!

I wanted to explore this adventure,so I signed up for Cosmetology school. Soon as I signed up for school I found out I was pregnant. I was high risk and was unable to go through with the program. I promised myself I would go back and pursue my dream. I tried again a year later and then was hit with a divorce. There I was a single mom. I had to focus on putting food on the table. I had to put my dream aside to focus on my son. My dream of being a cosmetologist got buried under all of life's circumstances. I just gave up on doing hair. I looked at my son and all the struggles I had to endure going up. I had to do something to better my family to break the cycle of poverty. I grew up being told that only people who carry degrees were successful, so I went back to school hoping to earn my Master's degree. Hoping my degree would make my son proud and my family proud. I spent 4 years at Valencia College. Yes, I spent four years at a two year college, but I hated it. I was not interested. I didn't feel alive. I remember finally being 1 semester away from graduating. I woke up one day and I realized this is not what I want to do! I wanted to do hair.

I searched everywhere. I called every cosmo school in Orlando. I couldn't find not one that was flexible with my schedule as a working and single mom of a teenage boy. It seemed impossible. I prayed and prayed to find a school. I had been creating my own ways and making my own plans. One day God reminded me he is the light of my hope!! Jermiah 29:11 says, For I know the plans I have for you declares, the Lord "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you HOPE and a future
